

## Dr Grant McBride General Pathologist (MBBS, FRCPA)

Dr Grant McBride graduated with a BSc (Information Science) and MBBS from the University of Melbourne in 1977. He did his internship and residency at Geelong Hospital where he also began his pathology registrar training with rotations in Chemical Pathology and Anatomical Pathology and completed the final two years of pathologist training at the Prince of Wales, Sydney in Microbiology and St Vincent's, Sydney in Haematology.

After completing his pathology training Grant returned to Melbourne and worked as a Pathologist in both the public and private sectors. In 1989 he moved to Hong Kong to work at the Prince of Wales Hospital, Shatin as a Microbiologist. In 1993 he was appointed the Director of Pathology at Townsville General Hospital. During his time as Director he oversaw the formation of a single integrated state-wide hospital pathology service (QHPSS) consisting of 31 laboratories including the Royal Brisbane Hospital and the introduction and commissioning of a new laboratory information system (LIS).

In early 2001 Dr McBride moved to Wollongong and worked as a General Pathologist in both the private and public sector with duties covering the whole spectrum of pathology including infectious disease and microbiology, chemical pathology, haematology and anatomical pathology. From 2001 to 2015 Grant also covered forensic services for the South Coast of NSW and in 2014/15 this service expanded to also cover the ACT.
